

Friday Street Car Boot Sale Buyers

Anyone displaying Covid-19 symptoms or with a temperature is **NOT** to attend Friday Street Car Boot Sale, for their safety and others.

These rules are here to allow us to re-open and keep our customers and team safe and should be adhered to and respected at all times.

1. Buyers are welcome from 6am.
2. A one-way system will be in operation down each row. Please only walk in the direction shown in the aisle and please do not cross through the sellers' rows.
3. Please ask sellers for prices on items, if not priced, before handling and please bring sufficient change with you.
4. If handling sellers' items please wear gloves and only handle items you are intending to purchase.
5. A queuing system will be in place for all catering. Please remain 2 metres apart from the person in front of you and observe the queueing system at all times. Catering facilities will be located at the end of a row, adhering to the one-way system, and will provide a take-away facility only.
6. The main entrance will be open, as usual, as will the top gate. Please note, when exiting from the top gate towards Ipswich, there is a one-way traffic system in operation. Whenever possible, please use this alternative exit to minimise traffic congestion on the car boot site.
7. Toilets will be available with a queuing system in place and will be regularly attended and cleaned, with hand sanitizer available on exit.
8. The collection point for picking up very heavy goods will be at the end of each row. Please ask a member of staff to help and supervise to avoid any traffic/safety issues. Driving down the aisles is strictly prohibited.

We have staff on site with radios, if you require any help or assistance, please speak to a member of the team, there will always be a member of staff available to help.

Social distancing will be implemented on site at all times, with the 2m rule applied to all visitors not from the same household.

If anyone is found in breach of these guidelines they will be asked to leave immediately.
